Step 1

Please read the following carefully, and answer questions 1 through 4 to determine if an Appalachian Power Company (APCO) permit is required.

- 1) Dredging can only be authorized for removal of accumulated sediment. The original lake bottom cannot be disturbed. Will you be disturbing the bottom of the lake or removing anything other than accumulated sediment?
2) Dredging is prohibited between elevation contours 1846 and 1844 in order to protect important aquatic wildlife habitat, unless approved by the Virginia Department of Wildlife Resources (VDWR). Are you proposing to dredge between the 1846 and 1844 elevation contours?
3) Dredging to a depth greater than 1840 is prohibited. Does your proposal require work to be done below the 1840 elevation contour?
4) Dredging less than 25 cubic yards may qualify under the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Nationwide Permit 19, and does not require a permit from Appalachian Power Company (APCO) as long as all other requirements of the Shoreline Management Plan (SMP) are met. Are you proposing to remove more than 25 cubic yards?

Please contact the USACE prior to beginning work to ensure compliance under Nationwide 19. Please sign and date this application on the next page to verify that the information you have provided is true and correct.

Step 2

An APCO permit is required in order to dredge 25 cubic yards or more of accumulated sediment. Please answer the following and attach the appropriate plans:

- 1. Has this location been dredged previously?
1a. If yes, when was dredging last performed?
1b. If no, dredging for <= 10 boat slips or > 10 boat slips
2. How many cubic yards of accumulated sediment will be removed?
3. Dredged and/or excavated material must be deposited outside the Project boundary. Please identify where the material will be deposited.
3a. If deposited on the same property, how will the dredged material be retained to prevent re-entry into the waterway?
3b. If deposited on another property, please provide the location including street address and/or county legal description and parcel identification.
3c. Will the dredged material be used for any commercial purpose?
4. Dredging and or excavation may not be performed between March 1st through July 31st each year in order to protect fish spawning, pistolgrip mussel spawning, and glochidia release. When will the proposed dredging activity take place?
5. Dredging or excavation of 25 cubic yards or more of accumulated sediment requires a permit from USACE. Please attach a copy of USACE authorization.
