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- While not a study, Appalachian agreed that a workgroup would be formed to:
 - Evaluate existing shoreline guidelines
 - Docks (private and commercial)
 - Shoreline Stabilization
 - Dredging



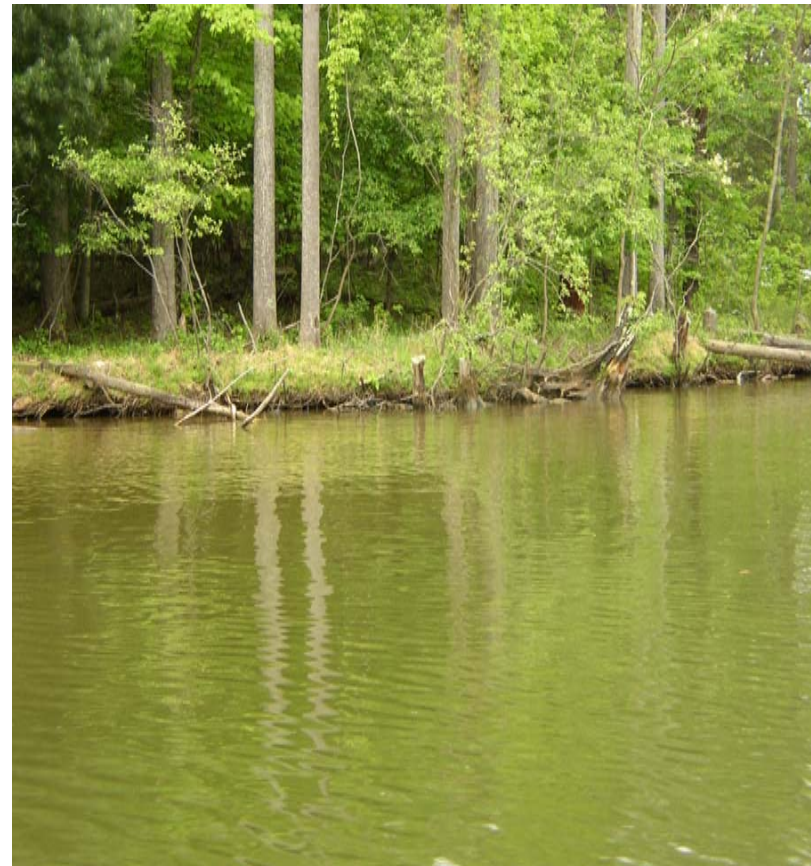
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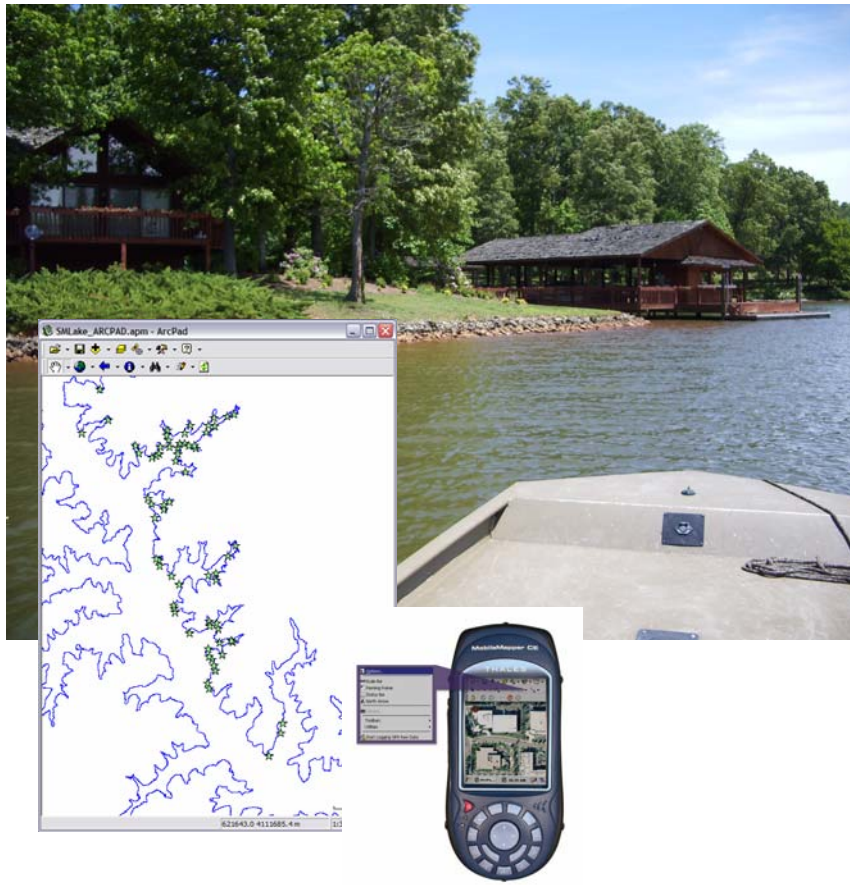
- Identify various resources that needed to be protected. For example:
 - Cultural resources
 - Wetlands
 - Aesthetic areas
 - Riparian areas
 - Habitat

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- Utilizing information / mapping obtained from the various relicensing studies
- Identify measures to protect these resources
- Revise guidelines as necessary to include these measures



To Date:



- Currently gathering all existing regulations and guidelines.
- Fieldwork for the first year of relicensing studies is being completed and draft study reports will be provided to each work group. These study reports will also be available to the SMP work group.
